Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules are in effect where sufficient boats are registered to form a One Design fleet.
- 1.4. All boats must have adequate means of self-propulsion or sufficient ground tackle to be able to maintain a position against adverse tides and conditions.
- 1.5. All Boats are required to have a functioning VHF radio aboard at all times.
- 1.6. Nothing in these rules shall be construed to relieve any participant from their duty to comply with health requirements

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at:
<https://race.cyc.org/fall22>
- 2.2. One entry per boat will be accepted.
- 2.3. All participating boats should have a valid 2022 BAMA or NCPHRF certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.

2.4. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration and may include Multi-hull, PHRF, J/105, AE28, J/24, J/70, J/88, Non-Spinnaker, One Design Short-handed and Sportboat. A fleet with five or fewer boats may be merged with another fleet or declined. BAMA and PHRF fleets will not be merged. Final fleet assignments will be set out in the sailing instructions

- **BAMA and PHRF fleets** may be grouped primarily based on their relevant assigned rating.
- **One Design fleets** are formed when five or more entries of that class are registered and will subject to their respective One Design class rules. One Design classes with six or more entrants, may have a separate start.
- **Short-handed Fleet** entrants may be accepted for those racing single or double handed. This will be a spinnaker fleet only.
- **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats, if accepted by the Race Committee. IOD's, Wyliecats and other cat boats shall race in the Spinnaker division. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees at its discretion.

3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta will be \$165 for each boat.
- 3.2. Entries must be received before October 6, 2022
- 3.3. Entries submitted after October 5, 2022 may be permitted at the discretion of the race organizer.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. Three races are scheduled in the regatta, with one race each day. October 8, October 22 and November 12.
- 4.2. First Warning Signal is scheduled at 12:30hrs on all race days.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than October 6, 2022 by 18:00hrs on the web site at: <https://race.cyc.org/fall22>

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply and will be included in the SI's.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Handicapped divisions will be scored time-on-time.
- 8.2. One race must be completed to constitute a series. There will be no throw-outs.
- 8.3. The time limit for each race will be 16:45 hrs. Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires will be scored TLE without a hearing. This changes *RRS* 35,A4 and A5.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information about time to start and recalls.

10. PRIZES

Series trophies will be presented at the CYC Clubhouse following the event.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
