



2023 Corinthian Fall Regatta

September 30, October 14, November 4

Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is the Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco.
- 1.2. RRS 40.1 will apply requiring competitors to wear Personal Flotation Devices.
- 1.3. One Design class rules are in effect where sufficient boats are registered to form a One Design fleet.
- 1.4. Nothing in these rules shall be construed to relieve any participant from their duty to comply with health requirements.

2. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 2.1. Three races are scheduled in the regatta, with one race each day.
September 30, October 14 and November 4.
- 2.2. The first warning signal is scheduled for 1230hrs on all race days.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the online entry form at:
<https://race.cyc.org/fall23>
- 3.2. One entry per boat will be accepted.
- 3.3. All participating boats should have a valid 2023 BAMA or NCPHRF certificate. The race committee may, at its discretion, waive the ratings certificate and/or, assign ratings to boats provisionally or finally where (a) YRA has not delivered an applied-for rating or (b) racing one-design or (c) racing non-spinnaker.

3.4. Fleets will be defined based on entry registration and may include Multi-hull, PHRF, J/105, AE28, J/24, J/70, J/88, Non-Spinnaker, One Design Short-handed and Sportboat. A fleet with five or fewer boats may be merged with another fleet or declined. BAMA and PHRF fleets will not be merged. Final fleet list will be set out in the sailing instructions

- **BAMA and PHRF fleets** may be grouped primarily based on their relevant assigned rating.
- **One Design fleets** are formed when five or more entries of that class are registered and will be subject to their respective One Design class rules. One Design fleets with six or more entrants, may have a separate start.
- **Short-handed Fleet** entrants will be accepted for those racing single or double handed and a separate fleet may be formed when five or more entries meeting the criteria are registered. This will be a spinnaker fleet only.
- **Non-Spinnaker Fleet** is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and other specified boats, if accepted by the Race Committee. IOD's, Wyliecats and boats identified as "no non-spin" by the YRA shall race in the Spinnaker division. Race Committee intend to assign the NCPHRF rating to non-spinnaker boats. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions may be subject to ratings modification by the Race Committees at its discretion.

4. FEES

4.1. The entry fee for the entire regatta will be \$150 for each boat.

4.2. Entries must be received before September 28, 2023

4.3. Entries submitted after September 28, 2023 may be permitted at the discretion of the race organizer.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available no later than September 29, 2023 by 1800hrs on the web site at: <https://race.cyc.org/fall23>

6. VENUE & COURSES

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix T1 section A of *RRS* will apply.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Handicapped divisions will be scored time-on-time.
- 8.2. One race must be completed to constitute a series. There will be no throw-outs.
- 8.3. The time limit for each race will be 1645 hrs. Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes *RRS* 35,A4 and A5.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

The Race Committee may make radio transmissions to communicate information about time to start and recalls.

10. PRIZES

Regatta trophies will be presented at the CYC Clubhouse following the event on November 4.

11. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance.
